

Further Update on the Status of Sinclair's Litigation with UPN

BALTIMORE, Dec. 11 /PRNewswire/ -- Sinclair Broadcast Group, Inc. (Nasdaq: SBGI) announced today that the Los Angeles Superior Court issued an Order staying United Paramount Network's action against Sinclair based on the summary judgment entered in favor of Sinclair on Monday in a companion action filed in Baltimore City Circuit Court. UPN had alleged in the California action that Sinclair failed to give timely and proper notice of its intention not to extend the current UPN affiliation agreements for nine stations owned or programmed by Sinclair. The nine stations are WNUV-TV, Baltimore, WPTT-TV, Pittsburgh, WSTR-TV, Cincinnati, KRRT-TV, San Antonio, KUPN-TV, Las Vegas, WTTV-TV, Indianapolis, KSMO-TV, Kansas City, KOCB-TV, Oklahoma City, and WCGV-TV, Milwaukee. Sinclair sought a stay in the California action today based on the summary judgment entered in the Maryland action that Sinclair had properly notified UPN of the termination of the affiliation agreements.
